Group Ticket Reservation Information



Group ticket reservations can be made for groups larger than 10 guests during general admission hours. Reservations must be made at least 3 days prior to the requested date. The Event Coordinator may purchase additional group tickets at the discounted rate on the day of the event. Tickets are only good for the date requested. Group ticket reservations are perfect for large family outings, school groups, summer camps, birthday parties and more!

- Free parking
- Concessions available or enjoy your own picnic lunch at a table inside the park. No glass containers or alcoholic beverages permitted.
- Changing rooms with showers and lockers for personal belongings
- Tubes for Rattler's Run at no additional charge
- Limited number of lifejackets available for slide use
- Guests will be measured and wrist banded according to height by Water Park staff, to ensure guests meet all slide height restrictions

Additional Information

- Tickets are good only on the requested date. No refunds.
- Tickets will be issued in the form of a scan card. The card will be issued to the Group Coordinator upon check in, and he/she will be responsible for the card. It is recommended that groups try to arrive together, but any guests arriving late will need to be scanned in by the Group Coordinator.
- Slide Height Restrictions
 - Otter Slide – 30"- 48", life jackets recommended, but not required
 - Humphrey's Slide – 42"-48", life jackets required
 - Crystal Slide – 42"- 48", life jackets required
 - Canyon Cooler – 48" and up, life jackets not allowed
 - Rattler's Run - 42"- 48", life jackets required
 - **Guests 48" and taller may enjoy all slides except the Otter Slide**

PARK COURTESIES

- Guests must comply with park rules and requests of park staff
- Climbing on decorative boulders is not allowed. .
- Food and drinks must be enjoyed at least 6 feet away from the pools and slides
- Wristbands are required for all guests over 30" tall and are mandatory for slide use.
- No running, and walk with caution when the surface is wet.
- All bags are subject to search. Refusal to bag search may result to non-admittance to the park. No alcohol. No glass containers.
- Smoking of any kind is not permitted in the park.
- No pets are allowed in the park, with the exception of service animals. Service animals are not permitted in the water.
- Diving and jumping into pools is not allowed.
- Public intoxication, unlawful drug use, vandalism or any other violation of City, County, State, Federal or Park Rules will result in ejection from park without refund and possible criminal prosecution
- The Water Park and it's attractions are subject to closure at any time, without notice

Dress Code

- Traditional swimwear is required. Provocative attire, street clothes, cut-offs, basketball shorts, gym clothes, and clothing with rivets, snaps, buttons, belts, or metal ornamentation are not permitted.
- Swim diapers (disposable swim diapers or plastic pants) are **required** for all diapered guests.
- No personal floatation devices may be brought into the park, with the exception of Coast Guard approved Type 3 life jackets, which are required for guests 42"-48"
- Snorkels, face masks, and fins are not permitted.
- Guests are encouraged to wear water shoes while walking around the Water Park, but shoes are not permitted to be worn on any slides.

HEALTH AND SAFETY

- Please shower prior to enjoying our pools and attractions
- Guests that have experienced stomach and/or intestinal illness within the past two weeks should not enter the water.
- Guests with open wounds or bandages are not permitted to enter the water.
- Guests are required to wash their hands after using the restroom and/or after changing a diaper. Diaper changing on or around the pool deck is not permitted.
- Do not drink water from any pools or attractions. Drinking fountains are available for water consumption
- Report all injuries to park staff
