Property Assessed Clean Energy Programs now available to Antioch Property Owners

Antioch – City Council approved the City of Antioch opting in to 3 PACE programs on December 16, 2014. Since that council meeting, staff has been working with the 3 programs to finalize indemnification and insurance agreements. In February, CaliforniaFirst was the first PACE program available to Antioch property owners. Figtree is now available for commercial property owners. They are planning to have a residential program but have not launched it yet. The Hero Program will be available sometime this summer.

Property owners wishing to finance an energy efficiency, water conservation or renewable energy project through a PACE program need to find a contractor that is signed up to participate in the programs. Each program has their own process for participating with contractors and the list of participating contractors differs. Property owners are responsible for doing their own research and deciding which program and which contractor they choose to go with. At this time, if residential property owners have improvements they wish to finance right now, their only option is CaliforniaFirst. www.californiafirst.org
